2% describe themselves in another way

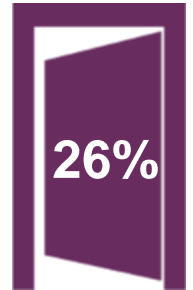
17% are aged between 16 and 24

74% have children



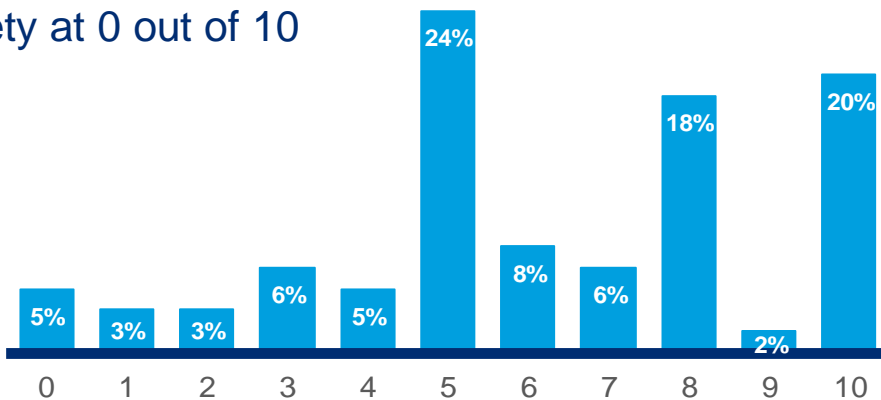
27% have other adults living in the home

What did they say?



“We are trapped under lockdown and he can turn up at any time”

“His emotional and verbal abuse is escalating the longer we're isolated and I'm concerned that mentally I won't survive this. I'm afraid that he will hurt himself or me, but in this situation, we can't go anywhere or calm down”



“I'm currently in a controlling emotionally abusive relationship and fear it could escalate like it has in the past due to heightened stress surrounding the current virus situation.”
