



# Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. How much is the grant funding?

The grant funding covers the salary, on-costs and 15% management costs for these roles for the duration of the project (Jan 2024 – Dec 2026).

The table below details the amount which will be issued per area, per year inclusive of the salary, on costs and 15% management costs.

Please note that the funding for January – December 2024 will be pro rata.

Jan – Dec 2024 Pro Rata	Jan – Dec 2025	Jan – Dec 2026
£48,138	£49,582	£51,070

Please note that the grant funding is the total amount for the project and covers both the adult and the child roles.

Therefore, if you are only applying for one of the roles, your budget should reflect this.

## 2. Can services create a consortium to apply for this work?

Yes we would welcome expressions of interest from individual services or a consortium of services.

## 3. If successful would we work in all three local areas?

No, services are applying to work in one specific area either Bolton, Leicestershire or Sheffield. If agencies wish to work in more than one area, they must submit an EOI for each area.

## 4. Can we apply for the Children and Young People role only?

Yes. We acknowledge that there are different skills required when working with children and young people and that there are dedicated services working with child victims of Domestic Abuse.

Therefore, services can apply for both roles or just the adult or children and young people role.

## 5. When will decisions for grant funding be made?

We are planning to make final decisions for successful grant awards by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> May.

**6. Are the AVC roles funded from appointment date or for the duration of the project?**

The AVC roles will be funded by this project until the end of December 2026.

**7. We would like to apply for both Adult & CYP AVC roles, do we need to submit two EOIs?**

No, you are only required to submit one EOI, regardless of whether you apply for one of, or both the Adult and CYP roles.

**8. Is there a salary scale for the AVC roles?**

We are providing a grant which is inclusive of salary costs, oncosts, and management costs. We can confirm that we do not specify a salary scale for the AVC roles as we acknowledge that organisations will have their own salary scales and will want to ensure equity amongst staff within services. By providing a grant amount this also allows organisations to be flexible in the proposals they are submitting.
